GrainCorp's Cunningar facility enters final phase

GrainCorp today announced its new site at Cunningar near Harden in New South Wales was nearing completion as commissioning is now underway.

Commissioning is designed to test the systems and processes of the site before it is officially opened on the 19th of December.

GrainCorp's regional manager for southern New South Wales, Sarah Roche said: "This is the next milestone for our facility in Cunningar. We have had deliveries of canola which allows us to wet-test the system.

"So far testing has been extremely successful with the mechanical and electrical systems operating as designed. We have also been very happy with the initial speeds achieved. We successfully out-loaded our first test train last Tuesday morning which is a great achievement for the project team.

"The project started in mid-February this year so we have made fantastic progress to be at this stage as harvest activity is ramping up," Ms Roche said.

Subject to successful commissioning, the site will be fully operational in mid-December. The bunker site is already open for harvest deliveries.

The new site is jointly funded by the Australian Government, Local Community, Hilltops Council and GrainCorp.
